MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

NOVEMBER 2, 2022

Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilmember Allen gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on October 19, 2022 were discussed. Motion to accept the minutes as written for 10/19/2022 was made by Councilmember Allen. Councilmember Tillotson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Bills in the amount of \$49,980.27 and payroll in the amount of \$9,926.72 were reviewed for payment approval. Councilmember Tillotson moved that the bills be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Fluckiger seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome reported that the fire department had assisted the county on a house fire.

Mayor Barthlome presented Ralph Spackman as a new member of the planning and zoning commission. Councilmember Fluckiger moved to approve Ralph Spackman. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Clerk Reeves administered the Oath of Office to Ralph Spackman. His term will expire in November of 2025.

Mayor Barthlome asked the city council to start looking over the weed ordinance so that the city can make some updates to it. She asked them to consider grazing property in the ag zone. Councilmember Allen feels that there needs to be more done with the canal property.

The city council discussed the updated animal ordinance. There is a change that needs to be made to the section on running at large. There is also a change that needs to be made to address the disposal of feral cats. Clerk Reeves will have these changes made and bring the ordinance back to an upcoming meeting.

City alcohol licenses were presented for 2023 as follows:

- Sam's Market for beer and wine - \$37.50
- EZ-Way for beer and wine- \$37.50

Councilmember Fluckiger moved to approve the licenses. Councilmember Tillotson seconded the motion. Motion passed with Councilmember Ridenour abstaining from voting.

Councilmember Allen moved to approve a Christmas bonus of \$100.00 for full-time employees and \$50.00 for part-time employees. Councilmember Fluckiger seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Clerk Reeves read a resolution concerning the destruction of records. Councilmember Tillotson moved to approve the resolution. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. The resolution will be numbered 2022-6.

Superintendent Crookston reported that the electrician was there this week wiring the aerators and the generator. Energy Management will come and start up the generator and Aeration Industries will come and start up the aerators. He also reported that himself, Mayor Barthlome, and Clerk Reeves had a meeting with Keller Associates about the sewer project. The project will probably begin construction in 2024. He purchased a new plow from the Idaho Transportation Department for \$350.00 to go on the new truck that was recently purchased.

Mayor Barthlome reported that the streetlights have all been replaced. There are a couple that aren't working, and she contacted Rocky Mountain Power about fixing them. She thanked Councilmember Tillotson and Stephanie Mangum for trimming the trees along Main Street. She thanked Clerk Reeves and the employees for all their hard work.
