

**CITY GRACE, IDAHO  
MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
HELD AT CITY HALL  
SEPTEMBER 4, 2024**

Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilmember Allen gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on August 21, 2024 were discussed. Motion to accept the minutes as written for 8/21/2024 was made by Councilmember Tillotson. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Bills in the amount of \$40,380.74 and payroll in the amount of \$11,434.79 were reviewed for payment approval. Councilmember Toone moved that the bills be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Stanley Christensen's property was discussed. The city council is willing to deed Mr. Christensen approximately 40 feet on the west side of his property to match the properties on the south of him. Mr. Christensen will need to get the property surveyed and a legal description so that the city can deed it to him.

The city council discussed the fees throughout the ordinance book. It was decided that many of the chapters in the ordinance book need to be updated to remove contradictions and to make the fees more balanced throughout the whole book. The council will start going through the ordinance book chapter by chapter to help bring it up to date.

Superintendent Crookston reported that the company working on the sewer upgrade has started some work in town but most likely won't start working on the sewer lines until the spring. They got the sweeper repaired and worked on sweeping the streets today. They will be paving the intersection at 4<sup>th</sup> West and 10<sup>th</sup> South and fixing the hole on 1<sup>st</sup> South on Friday. He has been working on the water adjudication and a new site sample plan.

Mayor Barthlome reminded the city council of the homecoming parade on Friday. The city council will be using a fire truck. She thanked the employees for their hard work.
