MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

OCTOBER 2, 2024

Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilmember Toone gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on September 18, 2024 were discussed. Motion to accept the minutes as written for 9/18/2024 was made by Councilmember Allen. Councilmember Bingham seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Bills in the amount of \$78,553.50 and payroll in the amount of \$10,597.18 were reviewed for payment approval. Councilmember Tillotson moved that the bills be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Toone seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Superintendent Crookston presented the following permits that were approved:

#2024-23 Caribou County – Multipurpose Building

#2024-24 Levi Spencer – New Home

Mayor Barthlome called for a motion to amend the agenda to add a roll call vote for the resolutions passed at the last meeting since it was neglected at the last meeting. Councilmember Bingham moved that pursuant to Idaho Code §74-204 amend the agenda for the meeting to rectify the roll-call vote on fee increase resolutions for water, sewer, and garbage. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome called for a roll call vote on Resolution 2024-1. Roll call vote was as follows: Larry Allen – yea, Kathy Tillotson – yea, Curtis Toone – yea, Kyle Bingham – yea. The roll call vote was unanimous.

Mayor Barthlome called for a roll call vote on Resolution 2024-3. Roll call vote was as follows: Larry Allen – yea, Kathy Tillotson – yea, Curtis Toone – yea, Kyle Bingham – yea. The roll call vote was unanimous.

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Mayor Barthlome explained that the city received the full amount of money for the Center Street bridge project a while ago and had put the money in a savings account until it was needed so that it could earn some interest. She found out that the savings account is only earning .41% interest. The city could put some of the money in a 6-month CD for 4.38% interest. She spoke with Jared at Keller Associates to see what the city might need for engineering for the next 6 months. He said he would feel comfortable with the city moving \$700,000.00 to a 6-month CD. Councilmember Tillotson moved that the city put \$700,000.00 of the money for the Center Street bridge project into a 6-month CD. Councilmember Toone seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Superintendent Crookston reported that they have been cleaning up and servicing the equipment to get ready for winter. GSE is still potholing for the sewer project. The divers will be here to clean the tanks in November, it will cost approximately \$9,000.00. Superintendent Crookston will be off October 9th – 14th and the 17th & 18th.

Mayor Barthlome asked the city council who would be attending the Association of Idaho Cities meeting on October 23. None of the councilmembers will be able to attend. Mayor Barthlome and Clerk Reeves will attend. The Senior Citizens will be having a potato bar dinner on October 17th. She thanked the employees for getting the water line run to the school's new greenhouse. She thanked Clerk Reeves for her work getting the year end closed up. She reported that the sidewalk project should be done tomorrow.

Employee Jake Wright reported that the grit removal system should be here in December.
