

**CITY GRACE, IDAHO
MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT CITY HALL
JUNE 19, 2024**

Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Barthlome excused Superintendent Crookston and Councilmember Bingham

Councilmember Toone gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on June 5, 2024, were discussed. Motion to accept the minutes as written for 6/5/2024 was made by Councilmember Tillotson. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Bills in the amount of \$12,451.36 and payroll in the amount of \$12,166.37 were reviewed for payment approval. Councilmember Allen moved that the bills be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Toone seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Lead Man Wright presented the following permits that were approved:

- #2024-12 – Rex Parkinson – lean-to
- #2024-13 – Brian Smith – New home

Mayor Barthlome turned the time to Tim Ochsenein. Mr. Ochsenein just purchased a new house in town and is interested in purchasing a small area of land north of the property that the city owns. It is an area that the city must mow. Mr. Ochsenein would rather the property was a part of his lot and he would plant it in grass and take care of it. Mayor Barthlome told him that the city will discuss it with the attorney and get back to him.

Amanda Collins presented an amendment to the contract that the city has with the Southeast Idaho Council of Governments (SICOG) for the administration of the Wastewater Treatment Project. The amendment was due to the city receiving more funds. Councilmember Allen moved to accept the amended contract. Councilmember Tillotson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome presented the name of Larry Thomas to finish the term of Kyle Bingham on the zoning commission, due to Kyle Bingham being appointed to the city council. Councilmember Toone

moved to approve Larry Thomas as a member of the zoning commission. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Clerk Reeves administered the Oath of Office to Larry Thomas as a member of the zoning commission.


Councilmember Tillotson moved to nominate Councilmember Allen as Council President. Councilmember Toone seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

The budget work meeting will be held on July 23, 2024.

Lead Man Wright reported that Superintendent Crookston would like to get water meters for all the city properties so that they can see if the city properties are losing water due to water leaks. Some of the employees went to the springs this week and found a pipe that was losing water due to a rock rolling down and hitting the pipe. They reported that the road is washing out and the city is losing a lot of water.

Mayor Barthlome thanked the employees, Clerk Reeves, and the missionaries for all their hard work. She reported that Soda Springs Main Street will be closed for about a month starting July 8th while redoing the road.
