MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT CITY HALL
APRIL 17, 2024

Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilmember Toone gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on April 3, 2024, were discussed. Motion to accept the minutes as written for 4/03/2024 was made by Councilmember Allen. Councilmember Fluckiger seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Bills in the amount of \$25,211.28 and payroll in the amount of \$12,200.37 were reviewed for payment approval. Councilmember Tillotson moved that the bills be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome reported that Fire Chief Peck had let her know that the new radios had been received.

Superintendent Crookston presented the following permit that was approved:

Mayor Barthlome turned the time to Laura Peck with the Chamber of Commerce. Mrs. Peck explained that the Chamber of Commerce is holding a concert in the park this year and bringing in the band Due West. They have received donations for most of the cost of bringing them but need a little bit more to get it all paid for. Mrs. Peck asked the city council if they would be able to donate. Councilmember Tillotson moved to donate \$1,000.00. Councilmember Toone seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Allen moved to set the budget hearing on August 21, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. Councilmember Fluckiger seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Allen moved to approve the hiring of a summer helper at \$13.00 per hour. Councilmember Tillotson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Fluckiger moved to approve the use of a service missionary from the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints one day a week to help where needed. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome called for a motion to suspend the rule requiring that an ordinance be read on three separate occasions. Councilmember Fluckiger moved that the council suspend the rule requiring that an

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ordinance be read on three separate occasions. Councilmember Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Clerk Reeves read Ordinance 2024-3 stating that before any building done in the city will require a survey or the existing survey marker must be located. Councilmember Toone moved to approve Ordinance 2024-3. Councilmember Tillotson seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken as follows: Councilmember Allen – yea, Councilmember Tillotson – yea, Councilmember Toone – yea, Councilmember Fluckiger – yea.

Superintendent Crookston reported that Bear River Electric can put a power monitor at the Wastewater Treatment Plant that will help when there are power flickers, and the power company sends two phase power instead of three phase for \$695.00. He stated that the employees have been getting ready for spring. He went to lead copper training and stated that more testing and reporting will be required.

Mayor Barthlome reported that the county will start construction on their new event center in May. The state legislature passed a new impact area bill that states that a city impact area can only be two miles from the city limits. The city will have to change the impact area that is currently set. The county will help with it. She thanked the employees for all their help. She reminded the city council of spring clean up June 3rd through the 8th.

Councilmember Tillotson told Superintendent Crookston of some pot holes that need to be filled.

Councilmember Toone asked if the city could help the school get the rest of the old elementary cleaned up.


Mayor Barthlome called for a motion to go into executive session. Councilmember Fluckiger moved that the board pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206(1)(a)&(b) convene in executive session to consider personnel matters at 6:46 p.m.. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Allen. A roll call vote was taken as follows: Councilmember Allen – yea, Councilmember Tillotson – yea, Councilmember Toone – yea, Councilmember Fluckiger – yea.


The city council discussed personnel matters.
